

The building is in such a condition that the effective life cannot be more than 20 years and after this period, the building will have to be rebuilt at an estimate cost of Rs. 100000/-. The rent being paid is fair and likely to be maintained provided yearly repairs are regularly carried out. Assume cost of annual repair 7% of the gross rent. Years purchase for 20 years @ 7% allowing for the redemption of estimated cost to rebuilt, the building @4%. Other outgoing are 18% of gross rent. Consider one year rent shall be lost due to rebuilding.
